The Jesse Brown VA Medical Center's Community Resource and Referral Center (CRRC) exemplifies the facility's commitment to providing excellent care and services in an environment of compassion that respects homeless Veterans and their families as well as those at-risk of homelessness.

The CRRC is a service center located in the community that offers a one-stop shop approach to prevent or end Veteran homelessness.

Eligibility

Veterans who are homeless or at risk for homeless are eligible to apply for our services. Veterans who are not eligible for VA health care may still be eligible for the Grant & Per Diem program or community services.

The CRRC utilizes federal, state, and local partners to provide services for homeless and at-risk Veterans.
